(In margin: Married Woodford of Essex a miller and farmer.)

Mary Taverner was borne ye twelfth of January in ye yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred and seventy seven. God make hir his servant forever.

(In margin: Married Corbin of Ringwood who (had?) 4 sons John, Henry, Wule & Dan.)

Abraham Taverner was borne ye six day of February att seven o'clock in ye night in ye yeare 167 - God make him his servant for ever.

(In margin: dyed a Bachelor.)

Isark Taverner was borne ye fifteen Day of March in the morning in ye yeare 1680 God make him his servant for ever.

(In margin: Died a Bachelor at Poole.)

Rachell Taverner was borne the 22 of May 1682 about eight o'clock in the morning. God make him his servant for ever.

(In margin: Married Mr Francis Lester has 12 children and died Jan. 28th (?) 1768 leaving 3 sons and 1 daughter.)

Ye 25 of October my wiffe Mary Taverner departed the Life in the yeare 1684.

Ye 25 of Apperrll William Taverner Sr departed this Liffe 1693.

Mary Corbin second daughter of Wm. and Mary Taverner Departed this Life in 1759.

Rachell Lester 3rd Daughter of Wm. and Mary Taverner who Departed this Life ye 24th of Jany. 1768 in ye 86 year of her age.

(In a different hand) Francis Lester husband of Rachell died 8 July 1737 aged 69 or 70 years.

Restated Feb. 1874 Ash Wednesday by John Bingley Garland in his 83 year

Susannah died unmarried at Poole Aged 21 years.

Amy married George Garland by whom she had Eleven Children and died in London 24 Feby. 1819 aged 59 years.

Sarah married James Pointer by whom she had Eight Children, Clara, Marianna, Susan, Sarah, James, Elizabeth, Amy and Louisa.

The above John Lester was Knighted on presenting an Address to George the Third on the Peace of Amiens.
