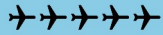

Kai Tak airport closed in 1998, but was famous for its dangerous flight path through the surrounding city and mountains. It became referred to as the 'Kai Tak Heart Attack', because the planes turned so close to the ground; at under 45m, this was less the wingspan of a medium-size airliner. The turn was so low that passengers could see television sets running in people's residences near the airport.
