

## Juancho E Yrausquin (SAB)



ALT: 18m  
RWY: 275m  
A/Y: 473,965

With high hills on one side, sheer drops at each end, the shortest commercial runway (400m, but only 275m of it usable), and heavy crosswinds, landings at Saba require precise manoeuvres, including steep descents and late flares.

Green (13, 🌿)

The wind dial starts at speed zero with the wind direction blowing from East to West.

Yellow (8, 🌿)

The wind dial starts at speed zero with the wind direction blowing from East to West.

Red (8, 🌿🌿)

The wind dial starts at speed three with a standard tailwind.

Black (8, 🌿🌿🌿🌿)

The wind dial starts at speed three with a standard tailwind.
